

ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

January 28, 2014

The Advisory Council received an update from the WFN Law Enforcement Officer (“LEO”). As is typical for winter months, things have been fairly quiet. The LEO updated the Advisory Council on what WFN has been doing in the area of emergency operations management so as have all their staff trained and ready to put emergency operations into action in the event of a community emergency.

The Advisory Council also received an update on the Sneena Road & Overpass Project from the Project’s Communications Officer, Evelyn Lube. This project is one of 4 projects contained in a 1983 agreement between WFN and the Province of B.C. The contract for the project has been awarded to Emil Anderson Construction who anticipates starting construction in March. Invitations will be going out shortly for a local area residents’ meeting where local residents will have the opportunity to view the project plans and have any questions answered.
