

ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

April 8, 2014

The next Residents' Annual General Meeting ("AGM") will take place on April 24th at the Sensisysten Community Centre. This is an opportunity for residents of WFN lands to attend an open house style meeting to hear about some of the recent developments and activities on WFN lands. WFN will be entering the Provincial level of Communities in Bloom ("CIB") this year, with the intention to enter the national level next year. WFN will once again be partnering with the District of West Kelowna ("DWK") for this initiative. As a part of the completion, the following events are being planned:

- Community Clean Up – June 7
- Most Beautiful Contest – No registration for this contest is required. WFN and DWK staff will tour the two communities in June looking for front yards with great curb appeal (greenery, floral and cleanliness.) Those nominated will receive a door hanger notice informing property owners that their properties have been nominated.
- Flower Barrel Placement – Both local governments will be placing large flower barrels in public spaces throughout the two communities for the purpose of beautification.
- Awards Ceremony – The awards ceremony for the finalists of the Most Beautiful Contest will be held in July.
