**1. Kamloops Sun Rivers Meeting Overview**

The Advisory Council reviewed their recent attendance to the Sun Rivers community in Kamloops comparing abilities of residents from Sun Rivers to those residing on Westbank Lands.

**2. Review of FAQs for Lakeridge Park Residents**

The Advisory Council discussed resident concerns that will need to be addressed in upcoming discussions concerning the Lakeridge Park leases. The Advisory Council will continue to work with WFN administration prior to an open house with Lakeridge Park residents.

**3. Considerations for the FY 2017/2018 LGS Budget**

The Advisory Council discussed potential items to be identified as recommendations to WFN Council in their reviewing of the 2017/2018 Local Government Services budget.

**4. Review of Draft Parks and Trails Plan and Sidewalk Implementation Plan**
