- 1. Review and Execution of the Carbon Tax Letter to the Premier's Office**
The Advisory Council executed a letter to the Premier's Office requesting a meeting to discuss concerns of Westbank residents. Westbank residents are currently unable to receive the Province issued carbon tax rebate. The Advisory Council has received the support of WFN Council in pursuing this matter with the Province.
- 2. Advisory Council Video Update**
The Advisory Council met with Rick Sagayadon to review the planned Advisory Council video project. The Advisory Council will further meet next week to begin filming elements of the video for a proposed release in the New Year.
- 3. Quarterly Financial Update**
The Advisory Council received an update from representatives of WFN's Financial Services Department. The Advisory Council will meet again with Financial Services in December to review the initial draft of the next fiscal budget and provide feedback.
- 4. Consultation Notice for Lot 364-1**
The Advisory Council met with WFN's Senior Planner to review the proposed development of a residential development consisting of micro-suites. The Advisory Council provided their support the development with the request that further consideration be given to the potential impact on traffic and parking within the surrounding area.
- 5. Capital Projects Update**
The Advisory Council received an update from Development Services on capital projects that will be focused on in the upcoming fiscal year. An updated plan will be presented to the Advisory Council once the fiscal year 2019 budget is finalized.
- 6. Overview of the Business Walk Results**
