sənsisyustən Building Renovation & Expansion September '18 Update

The expansion and renovation of the sənsisyustən House of Learning continues to make progress as we move into October 2018.

Budget:

- The sənsisyustən renovation and expansion is under budget with more than 70% of the project tendered or completed; meaning the cost has been fixed. The cumulative total of all tendered subtrades remains \$335,026 below budget and \$939,803 remains in the project contingency fund.

Employment:

- Four WFN members are working on site with Greyback Construction Ltd.
- One WFN member is affiliated with the project.
- One sub trade tender was awarded to WFN owned company (Civil scope).
- Greyback continues to look for WFN member Carpenters, electricians or plumbers. Apply with Greyback if interested

Solar Project update:

- The rooftop solar project is currently in design stages and a contractor has been selected. The preliminary schedule for the solar panels is spring/summer 2019. A Feasibility study and public consultation completed in 2017 confirmed the community supported rooftop solar power at the school and \$150,000 in grant funding has been secured. The remaining \$117,000 will be funded by WFN between Taxation (\$77k) and Own Source (\$40k). This project is expected to provide training and employment opportunities for members.
