



1. Bi-Annual Meeting with yí səx^wk^wínmaʔmⁱⁱ (Council)

In accordance with Section 8.2 of the WFN Advisory Council Law, the Advisory Council will be meeting with yí səx^wk^wínmaʔm on siyaʔtənⁱⁱⁱ (June) 14, 2021 to discuss matters of relevance to non-Member residents. Section 8.2 of the Law requires yí səx^wk^wínmaʔm to meet with the Advisory Council at least twice in each calendar year.

2. Recommendation to Approve WFN Local Revenue Law 21-LRL-02

The Advisory Council recommended approval of WFN Local Revenue Law 21-LRL-02, which authorizes the Utility Water and Sewer Reserve in Local Government Services Fund 59 Expenditure for Carrington Road Gellatly Road Roundabout Project on Tsinstikeptum Indian Reserve No. 9 at a maximum cost of \$45,000. This is an opportune time to proceed with this water main installation project because the City of West Kelowna is already digging up the roadway to complete one of their own projects. WFN will contribute \$45,000 to the overall cost of \$150,000.

3. Homeowner Grant

At their míktúʔtin (May) 3, 2021 Council meeting, yí səx^wk^wínmaʔm approved the basic homeowner grant of \$570, the additional homeowner grant of \$845, and an increase of the phase out threshold from \$1,525,000 to \$1,625,000. This decision mirrors the Province's actions on the homeowner grant.

4. Next Meeting

The next Advisory Council meeting is scheduled for siyaʔtən (June) 8, 2021, 9:00 a.m.

ⁱⁱ yí səx^wk^wínmaʔm (Council) Those who have been chosen by the people to be responsible for (səx^w) working (k^w) to oversee things (ínmaʔm). Traditionally, yí səx^wk^wínmaʔm were chosen to oversee hunting and fishing or to serve as policeman but the term has now been broadened to incorporate the oversight of government.

ⁱⁱⁱ siyaʔtən (June) Moon of Saskatoon berry (siyaʔ means Saskatoon berry).
