### Chaperone Rules

- The ratio will be 5 youth to 1 Chaperone.
- The Chaperone must camp near the youth (ie. Within earshot)
- The Chaperone will ensure that:
  - ❖ The youth set up their own tent.
  - ❖ Responsible for transporting your youths.
  - ❖ Youths are fed and provided water.
  - ❖ The youth clean up their own area.
  - ❖ Chaperone responsible to your youth's wellbeing.
  - ❖ Any medication will be given to the Chaperone and administered by the Chaperone.
- The Chaperone is responsible for having the youth up and ready to leave in the morning.
- The Chaperone is responsible for curfew and that it is adhered to.
- There will be separate tents for boys and girls.
- The Chaperone will ensure youth have proper camping supplies (List will be provided).
- The Chaperone will ensure any injuries are reported as soon as possible to the First Aid.
