



Member's Only Beach Lot Rules and Regulations

USE

- One lot per member, for a maximum of 7 consecutive days or a minimum of 3 days rental
- One recreational vehicle and one tent permitted per lot
- There is to be no subletting of the beach lots
- No makeshift lodging of any kind. Only listed accommodation types are permitted
- The renter is responsible for all damages including damage caused by Guests

QUIET HOURS

- Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

GUESTS

- The number of Guests is limited to no more than 3 people
- All Guests parking is designated outside of the gate
- All Guests are to vacate the premises by 10:00 p.m.
- The renter is responsible for the conduct of Guests including any damages caused

PARKING

- A Maximum of Two (2) parking spots allotted per lot.
- If your vehicle cannot be contained within the beach lot area, please park in the designated Guest parking located outside of the gate.
- All vehicles and accommodations are to be within the boundaries of each beach lot so as to not impair the flow of traffic

SECURITY

- The gate must remain locked at all times
- Any renter or guest caught vandalizing the gate of any WFN properties will be immediately evicted from the beach lot area

PETS

- Under no circumstances are dogs, cats, or any other pets allowed in the beach lot area

SAFETY

- Unauthorized use of fireworks on Westbank Lands is strictly prohibited
- The renter shall abide by all burning regulations including campfire bans
