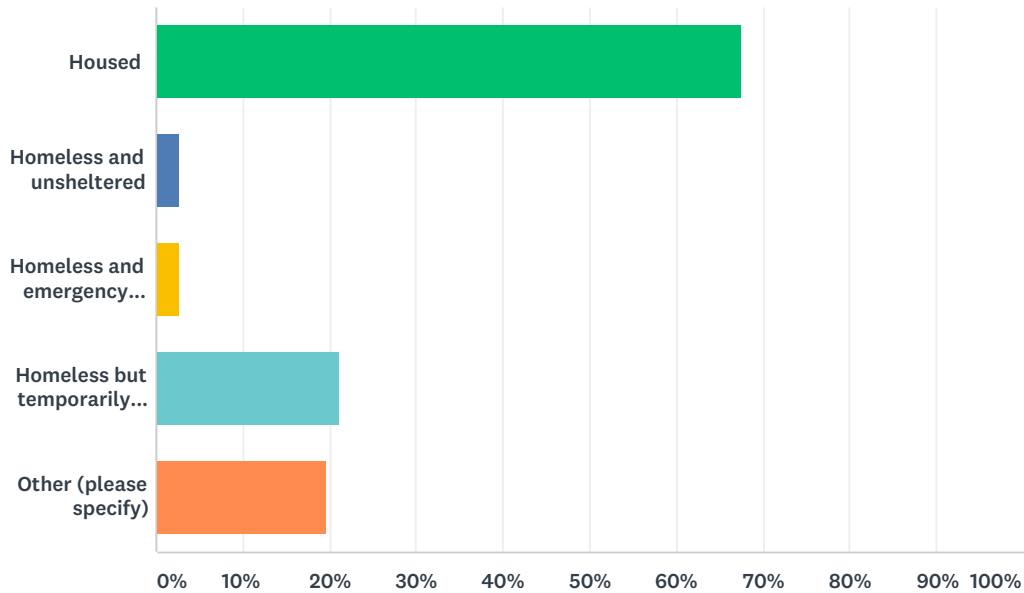


Q1 How would you describe your current housing situation?

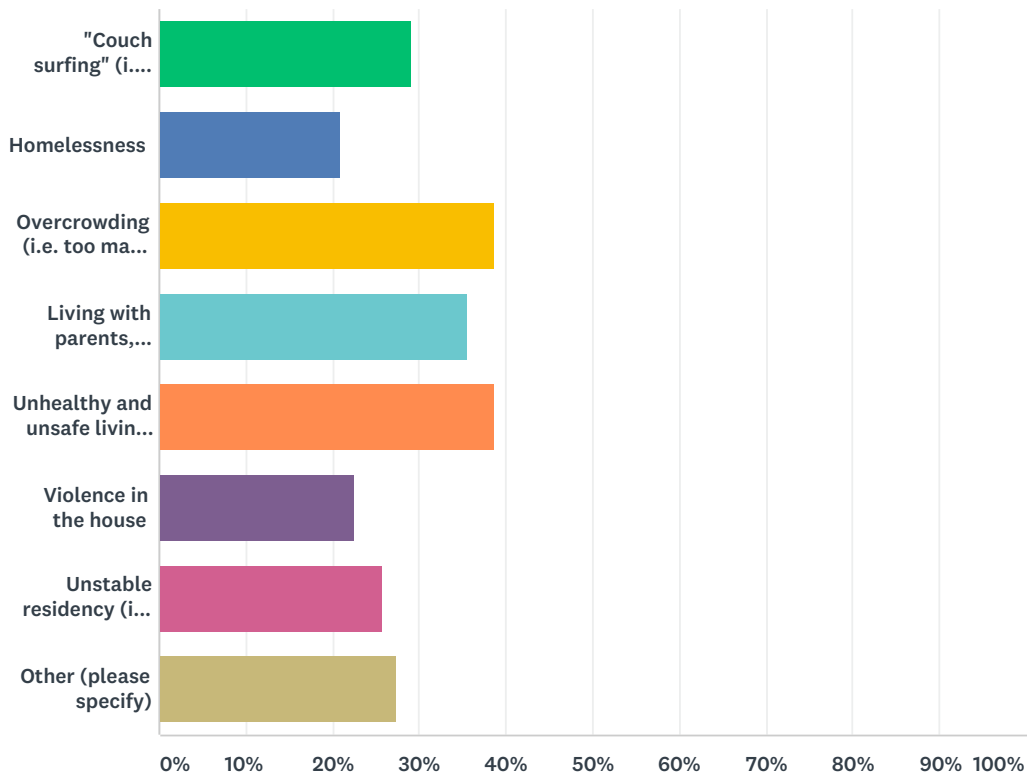

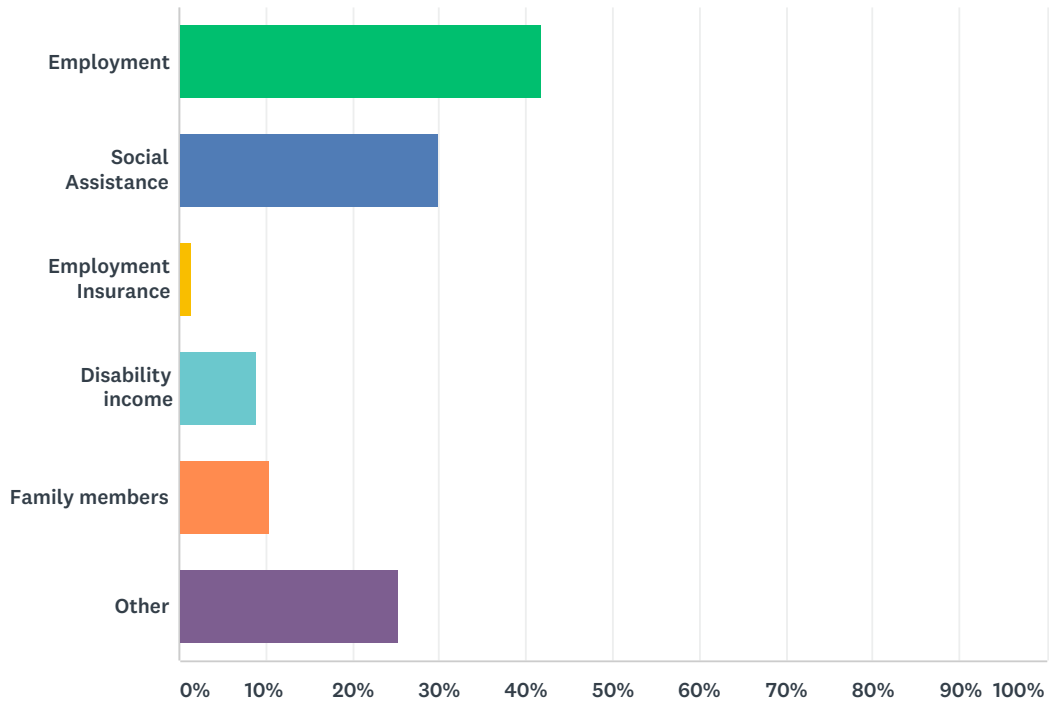

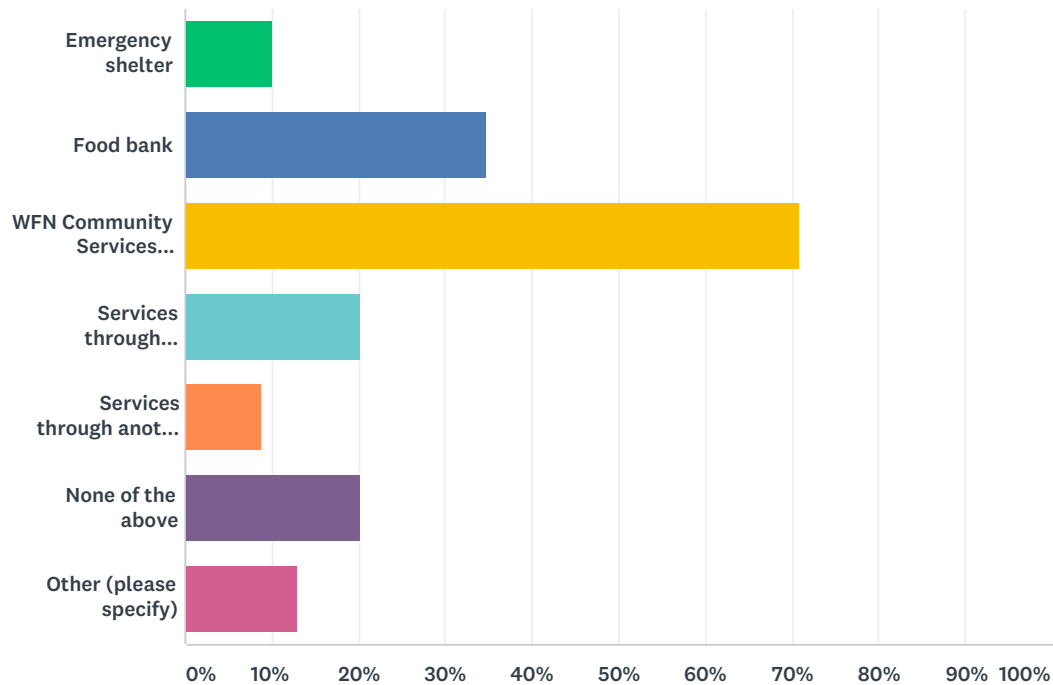

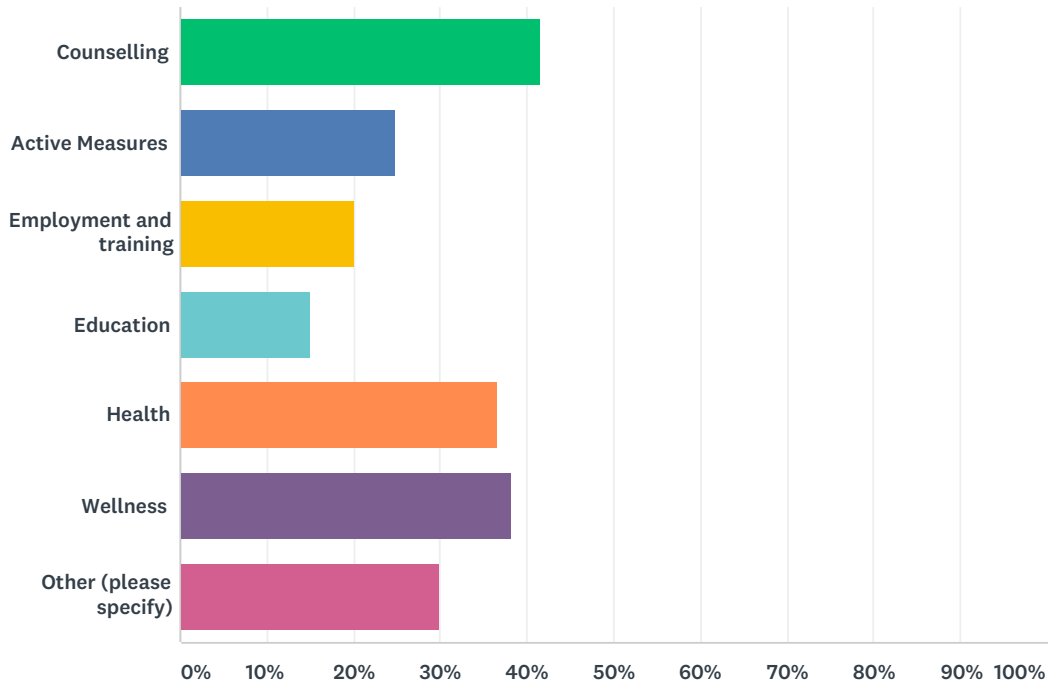

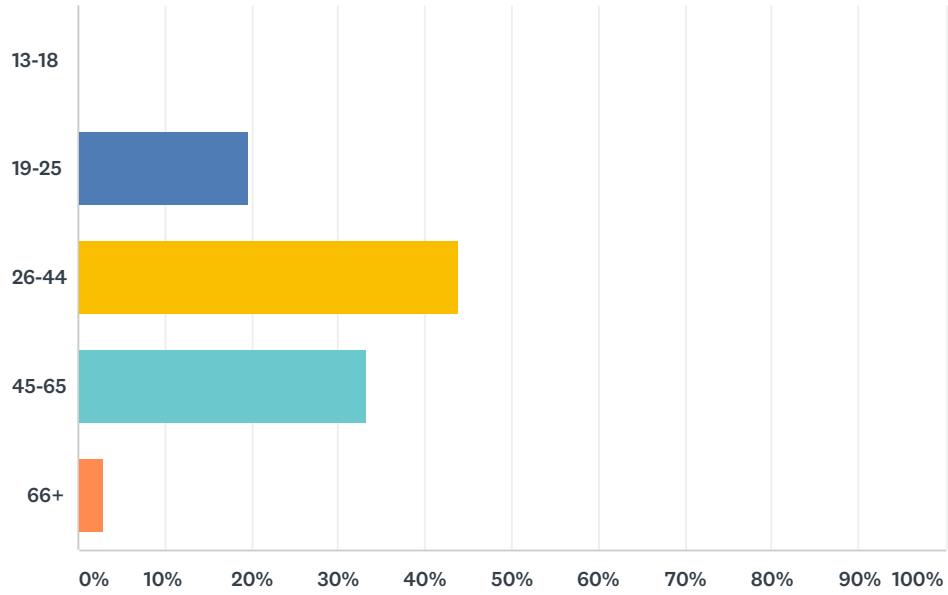

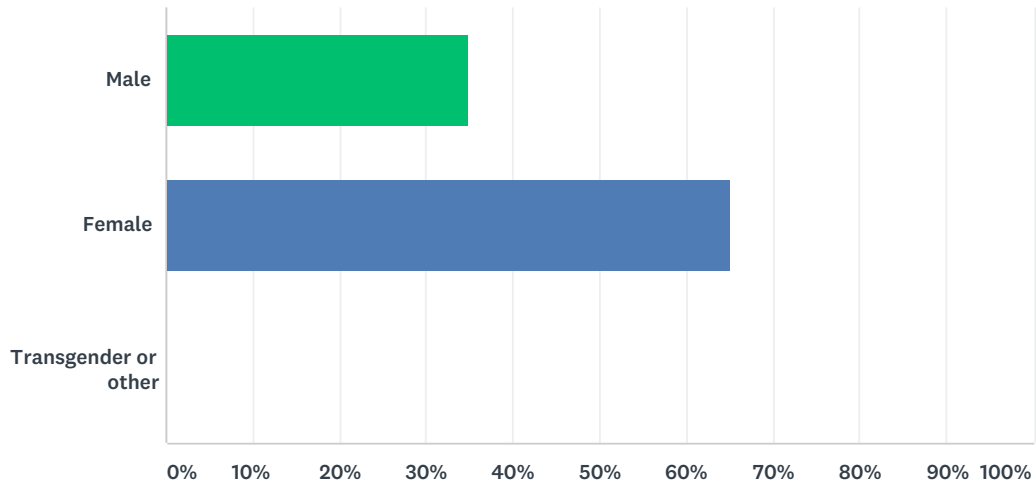

Q8 What is your gender?

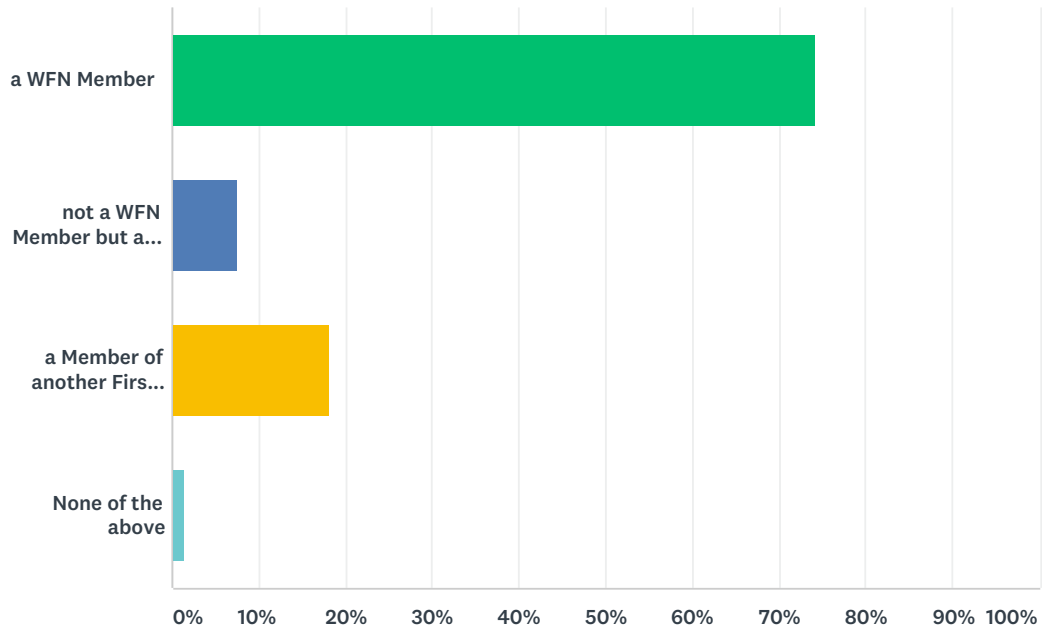
