- * Indoor Sneakers: Please insure that your child/ren have a pair of indoor non-marking sneakers, which are to be left at school. Please label your child's belongings.
- * If your contact information has changed, please advise Sherry as soon as possible.

Fees: School fees of \$40 per student are due by September 25, 2019. Lunch fees are \$20 per month, if your child is participating, and due at the beginning of each month. (Please remember to send healthy snacks each day with your child/ren!)

During the final processes of the school renovation/expansion, we will ensure the quality of academics will not be impacted. Safety is still our primary concern, so you will notice there is a lot of fencing in place to keep the children safe. If you are dropping off or picking up your child please make certain you are not impeding the flow of traffic and that you are parking in designated areas. All of the students are to enter the school area through the MPR (multi-purpose room.) There will be a one-way drop off zone — coming through the roundabout straight to the school with the ball diamond on your right continue to the grey railing and drop off your child at the top of the ramp to enter the MPR. If you are wanting to stay, please park along the wall by the MPR against the concrete meridians or in front of the gym. The first week of school prior to the breakfast program starting, the students will be going up to the ball diamond where the supervisors will watch them until the school day starts.

Each morning when breakfast is in full swing all students are to enter the MPR for breakfast. Students will keep all of their belongings with them in the MPR until the teachers gather all of their students and take them to their rooms and then to the circle area for morning announcements. Students can be dropped off at school no earlier than 8:00 am school starts at 8:25 am. Please note that when the breakfast program starts on Sept 9 students who arrive after 8:20 will not be served breakfast.
